Subject: Registration fees for tanker trucks

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FUELS/LIQ PETROLEUM GAS

EG +\$180,000 SG RV See Note

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Increases the tanker truck registration fee applicable to certain trucks transporting liquefied petroleum gas

Present law prohibits tanker trucks with a water capacity of 1,000 gallons or more from transporting liquefied petroleum gas unless it is registered with the Liquefied Petroleum Gas Commission and a \$50 annual registration fee is paid. Proposed measure increases the annual registration fee from the current \$50 up to a maximum of \$150.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

Proposed legislation will increase SGR revenues for the Department of Public Safety (DPS), Liquefied Petroleum Gas Commission by approximately \$180,000 annually from increasing registration fees from \$50 up to a maximum of \$150 for tanker trucks with water capacity of at least 1,000 gallons. OMV reports 1,800 tanker trucks apply for registration annually.

The \$180,000 increase for the Liquefied Petroleum Gas Commission is calculated as follows:

Proposed law (1,800 registrants x \$150 fee = \$270,000) Current law (1,800 registrants x \$50 fee = \$90,000)
