4	WHEREAS, the Louisiana office of motor vehicles provides a designation on driver's
5	licenses and identification cards for citizens who have special needs or require an
6	accommodation; and
7	WHEREAS, the Louisiana office of motor vehicles provides a designation on driver's
8	licenses and identification cards for an applicant that has autism spectrum disorder; and
9	WHEREAS, the Louisiana office of motor vehicles provides a designation on driver's
10	licenses and identification cards relating to organ donation or bone marrow donorship; and
11	WHEREAS, the Louisiana office of motor vehicles provides the phone number for
12	Crisis Lifeline on driver's license and identification cards; and
13	WHEREAS, several states provide applicants for driver's licenses and identification
14	cards the option of having additional health-related information including blood type
15	information on driver's licenses and identification cards for use in emergencies; and
16	WHEREAS, in emergency medical situations, immediate access to a person's blood
17	type can be critical for life-saving treatment; and
18	WHEREAS, it is in the public interest to evaluate the practicality, privacy

implications, and technical requirements of including blood type data on such documents; and

WHEREAS, this measure could enhance public's safety by equipping emergency responders with vital health information when time is of the essence.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby urge and request the Louisiana office of motor vehicles to conduct a comprehensive study on the feasibility of allowing individuals to voluntarily include their blood type on state-issued driver's licenses, permits, and identification cards.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the study consider costs, implementation logistics, public health benefits, legal and privacy concerns, and any necessary legislative or administrative changes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Louisiana office of motor vehicles report its findings and recommendations to the Senate Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public Works and to the David R. Poynter Legislative Research Library, as required by R.S. 24:771 no later than sixty days prior to the start of the 2026 Regular Session of the Legislature.
