HIGHER EDUCATION OR INCREASE GF EX See Note

Creates a uterine fibroids research center at Southern University

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Present law provides for the Southern University system, composed of postsecondary education institutions under the supervision and management of the system's board of supervisors. Proposed law establishes, subject to the constitutional powers, duties, and responsibilities of the Board of Regents, a fibroid research center under the supervision and management of the Board of Supervisors for the following purposes: (1) Conducting research on the causes of and treatments for fibroids. (2) Educating the community on such research findings. (3) Providing services not required to be administered by obstetrician-gynecologists.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

<u>Proposed law</u> will result in a significant but indeterminable increase in SGF expenditures to the Southern University System associated with establishing the Southern University Uterine Fibroids Research Center, conducting research, educating the community, and providing services. To the extent that federal grants are available for this purpose, some of the SGF expenditures may be mitigated with federal funds.

Initial estimates provided by the Southern University System indicate \$14.87 M for the first year (FY 26), which includes \$3.5 M for personnel costs, \$8.6 M for one-time equipment such as MRIs, ultrasound machines, laboratory equipment, and computing systems and \$2.9 M for operational costs. Subsequent years are estimated at \$5.5 -5.9 M annually, primarily for staffing (\$3.5 M, see page two) and operational costs (\$2 M).

The LFO anticipates that some of these costs can be mitigated by centralizing operations at a single campus rather than distributing across multiple locations. This would significantly reduce equipment, staffing, and overhead costs. Additionally, consolidating administrative functions, such as reducing the proposed three Executive Directors to one, and leasing equipment initially rather than purchasing would lower immediate capital outlays. Nevertheless, creating a research center will result in significant expenditures.

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REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure. However, there may be an opportunity to secure federal research grant revenue.
