COMMERCIAL REGULATIONS. Provides relative to the Uniform Construction Code Council. (8/1/25)

AN ACT

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 40:1730.22(A) and (D), to enact R.S. 37:2166 and R.S.
3	40:1730.22 (G) and (H), and to repeal R.S. 36:409(A)(3), relative to the Louisiana
4	State Uniform Construction Code Council; to provide for the transfer of power and
5	duties of the Louisiana State Uniform Construction Code Council; to provide relative
6	to membership of the council; to provide relative to the powers and duties of the
7	council; to provide for powers and duties of the State Licensing Board for
8	Contractors; and to provide for related matters.
9	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
10	Section 1. R.S. 37:2166 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
11	§2166. Louisiana State Uniform Construction Code Council; transfer of duties
12	A. The Louisiana State Uniform Construction Code Council shall be
13	placed within the State Licensing Board for Contractors and shall exercise its
14	duties, functions, and responsibilities under the management of the executive
15	director.
16	B. The executive director of the board shall serve as executive director
17	of the council and shall not have voting privileges.

1	C. The executive director shall have the authority to designate the
2	board's staff to the Louisiana State Uniform Construction Code Council as
3	needed.
4	Section 2. R.S. 40:1730.22 (A) and (D) are hereby amended and reenacted and R.S.
5	40:1730.22 (G) and (H) are hereby enacted to read as follows:
6	§1730.22. Louisiana State Uniform Construction Code Council; membership;
7	function of council; meeting requirements; immunity
8	A.(1) The Louisiana State Uniform Construction Code Council, hereinafter
9	in this Part referred to as the "council", is hereby created and shall consist of twenty
10	seventeen members, one of whom shall be the state health officer or his designee,
11	and one of whom shall be the fire marshal or his designee. as follows:
12	(a) The fire marshal or his designee.
13	(b) Two building code enforcement officers registered with the Louisiana
14	State Uniform Construction Code Council.
15	(c) One member who shall have had the greater part of their professional
16	experience as licensed electrician or licensed plumber.
17	(d) One member who shall have had the greater part of his professional
18	experience as a licensed mechanical engineer.
19	(e) Two members who shall have had the greater part of his professional
20	experience as a licensed architect, one of whom shall be a member of the
21	American Institute of Architects of Louisiana.
22	(f) One member who shall have had the greater part of his professional
23	experience as a licensed structural engineer.
24	(g) One member representing the Louisiana Home Builders Association.
25	(h) One member representing the Associated Builders and Contractors.
26	(i) One member who shall have had the greater part of his professional
27	experience as a licensed residential contractor.
28	(j) One member who shall have had the greater part of his professional
29	experience as a licensed commercial contractor and who is a member of the

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1	Louisiana Associated General Contractors.
2	(k) One member who shall have had the greater part of his professional
3	experience in the insurance industry.
4	(l) One member representing the Building Officials Association of
5	Louisiana.
6	(m) One member representing the Louisiana Building Code Alliance.
7	(n) Two members at-large.
8	(2) With the exception of the state health officer or his designee and the fire
9	marshal or his designee, who shall serve by virtue of his position, each member of
10	the council shall be appointed by the governor, subject to Senate confirmation, and
11	shall serve at the pleasure of the governor. With the exception of the state health
12	officer or his designee and the fire marshal or his designee, each term for a member
13	of the council shall be four years where a member shall serve no more than two
14	consecutive terms. Each member of the council shall serve without compensation but
15	shall may be reimbursed for actual expenses and mileage incurred while attending
16	council meetings in accordance with state travel regulations promulgated by the
17	division of administration. Reimbursement shall be limited to mileage and expenses
18	for the attendance of twelve meetings per calendar year. The executive director
19	shall have the authority to use the board funds for the operations of the
20	Louisiana State Uniform Construction Code Council.
21	* * *
22	D.(1) The council shall elect from its members a chairman and vice chairman.
23	The chairman shall serve as chairman for a maximum of four years from the date of
24	his election. The council shall adopt regulations under the Administrative Procedure
25	Act in order to implement the provisions of this Part. A meeting may be called by the
26	chairman on his own initiative and must be called by him at the request of three or
27	more members of the council within fourteen days of such request. Each member

must shall be notified by the chairman in writing of the time and place of the

meeting at least seven days before the meeting. Each meeting shall be open to the

1	public and any official decision of the council may be made only by a vote of at least
2	two-thirds of those members in attendance at the meeting provided that a quorum is
3	established prior to a vote. A majority of members of the council shall constitute a
4	quorum.
5	(2) The domicile of the council shall be East Baton Rouge Parish. The
6	council shall meet bi-monthly in East Baton Rouge Parish, unless directed to
7	meet more often by the chairman.
8	(3) The governor may remove any member of the council for cause or at
9	the request of the chairman for failure to attend more than half of regularly
10	scheduled meetings within a twelve-month period.
11	* * *
12	G. The executive director of the State Licensing Board for Contractors
13	shall serve as the executive director of the council and shall not have voting
14	privileges.
15	H. Notwithstanding any other provisions to the contrary and to the
16	extent deemed necessary or appropriate for the efficient implementation of its
17	responsibilities under this Chapter, the State Licensing Board for Contractors
18	is hereby vested with the authority to delegate its powers and duties to its staff.
19	The executive director shall have the authority to designate the board's staff to
20	the Louisiana State Uniform Construction Code Council as needed.
21	Section 3. R.S. 36:409(A)(3) is hereby repealed.
22	Section 4. The provisions of this Act shall supercede and control any conflict with
23	R.S. 40:1730.22(A) as amended by Section 1 of Act 534 of the 2024 Regular Session of the
24	Legislature.

## **DIGEST**

SB 228 Reengrossed

Abraham

<u>Present law</u> places the La. State Uniform Construction Code Council (council) within the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections (department).

<u>Proposed law</u> transfers the council <u>from</u> the department <u>to</u> the State Licensing Board for Contractors (board) and provides that the executive director of the board shall serve as the executive director of the council. Allows the board to utilize its staff to fulfill its responsibilities and duties with the council.

<u>Present law</u> creates the council, which consist of 20 members, one of whom shall be the state health officer or his designee and one whom shall be the fire marshal or his designee. Provides that with the exception of the state health officer and the fire marshal, each member of the council shall be appointed by the governor.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> except changes the number of members <u>from</u> 20 members to 17 members and provides for membership as follows:

- (1) The fire marshal or his designee.
- (2) Two building code enforcement officers registered with the council.
- One member who shall have the greater part of his professional experience as a licensed electrician or licensed plumber.
- (4) One licensed mechanical engineer.
- (5) Two licensed architects, one of whom shall be a member of the La. Associated General Contractors.
- (6) One licensed structural engineer.
- (7) One member representing the Louisiana Home Builders Association.
- (8) One member representing the Associated Builders and Contractors.
- (9) One licensed residential contractor.
- (10) One licensed commercial contractor who is a member of the La. Associated General Contractors.
- (11) One member with professional experience in the insurance industry.
- (12) One member representing the Building Officials Association of Louisiana.
- (13) One member representing the Louisiana Building Code Alliance.
- (14) Two members at large.

<u>Present law</u> requires the council to elect a chairman and vice chairman and provides for the terms each officer shall serve within the council. Requires the council to adopt regulations

under the Administrative Procedure Act, in order to implement provisions under present law.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds that the council shall be domiciled in East Baton Rouge Parish and clarifies that the council shall meet bi-monthly, in East Baton Rouge, unless directed to meet more often by the chairman. Eliminates the four year term limit for the chairman of the council.

<u>Present law</u> provides that members of the council shall serve without compensation but requires members to be reimbursed for actual expenses and mileage incurred while attending council meetings.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and removes the requirement for expense and milage reimbursement.

<u>Proposed law</u> allows the governor to remove members of the council for cause or at the request of the chairman for failure to attend more than half of regularly scheduled meeting within a 12-month period.

Effective August 1, 2025.

(Amends R.S. 40:1730.22(A) and (D); adds R.S. 37:2166, R.S. 40:1730.22 (G) and (H); repeals R.S. 36:409(A)(3))

## Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

## Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection, and International Affairs to the original bill

- 1. Provide that the executive director of the State Licensing Board for Contractors (board) shall have the authority to designate the board's staff to the council.
- 2. Change the number of members in the council from 19 to 17.
- 3. Remove the state health officer or his designee from the council and replaces that membership with two building code enforcement officers registered with the council.
- 4. Add a requirement that at least one licensed architect on the council be a member of the La. Associated General Contractors.
- 5. Add a requirement that the licensed commercial contractor on the council be a member of the La. Associated General Contractors.
- 6. Change the number of members representing the La. Building code Alliance from two to one.
- 7. Change the at-large members on the council <u>from</u> three <u>to</u> two.
- 8. Remove the requirement to reimburse council members for expenses and mileage incurred while attending meetings.
- 9. Eliminate the four year term limit for the chairman of the council.
- 10. Make technical changes.
