A RESOLUTION

To commend the students and faculty of the St. Tammany Parish School System for placing first in the Louisiana Governor's Games' 30th Annual Elementary State Championship Fitness Meet.

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Governor's Games are the state's premier amateur sporting event; since 1995, the Elementary State Championship Fitness Meet has served as the Olympic Games for elementary school-aged children in thirty parishes across the state, with more than two hundred thousand competing for the state fitness crown; and

WHEREAS, the St. Tammany Parish School System finished first overall in the 30th Annual Elementary State Championship Fitness Meet; St. Tammany scored 2,442 points, narrowly defeating Livingston Parish's total of 2,434 points and defending-champion Lafayette Parish's total of 2,421 points; and

WHEREAS, the Elementary State Championship Fitness Meet involves seven fitness-related events, including the fifty-yard dash, shuttle run, pull-ups, standing long-jump, sit-ups, the 600-yard run, and the V-sit and reach; and

WHEREAS, the top-two boys and girls from each parish travel to Pineville, Louisiana, each year to compete for the state fitness title; St. Tammany's top performer, Lillian Young, led all competitors with six hundred thirty-five individual points; and

WHEREAS, in addition to Lillian, the parish victory was anchored by Joseph Lacour, Reese Maras, and Benjamin Bearden; the competitors for St. Tammany Parish are most deserving of the highest recognition for their incredible achievements.
