WHEREAS, Bessie Smith played a vital role in community development, improving the Stoner Hill area block by block by installing drainage systems, defining boundaries, and enhancing infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, under her leadership, the C.E. Galloway Head Start Center was established; Bessie provided support to E.B. Williams Elementary Lab School, Valencia Community Center, and rehabilitation programs for senior citizens; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Smith's tireless efforts and volunteerism led to the Bessie D. Smith Park being named in honor of her service and contributions to the neighborhood; and WHEREAS, she was affectionately known as the "Mayor of Stoner Hill" and remained a tireless advocate for voter registration, youth programs, home rehabilitation, education, and community art; and

WHEREAS, Bessie Smith will be remembered for her love of reading, cooking, music, and most of all, her deep love for others, always guided by her cherished motto, "God is Love" and her words, "You Know I Love You"; her legacy of compassion, leadership, and service will forever remain in the hearts of the residents of her Shreveport community.
