2	To commend Viola Ford Fletcher, the oldest living survivor of the 1921 Tulsa race
3	massacre, on the occasion of her one hundred-eleventh birthday.
4	WHEREAS, Viola Ford Fletcher, also known as Mother Fletcher, is an inspiring
5	woman and humanitarian who exemplifies grace, dignity, resilience, perseverance, and
6	pragmatism; and
7	WHEREAS, Mother Fletcher is one of two living survivors of the 1921 Tulsa race
8	massacre which took place in the Greenwood District of Tulsa, Oklahoma, one of the
9	wealthiest black communities in the United States in the 1920s and known as "Black Wall
0	Street"; and
1	WHEREAS, Mother Fletcher lived in Greenwood with her parents and four siblings,
12	and she was only seven years old when the massacre forced her family to flee their home;

4	WHEREAS, Mother Fletcher testified before Congress on May 19, 2021, one
15	hundred years after the events of the Tulsa race massacre, and recounted the lasting impact
16	that the tragedy has had on her life; and
17	WHEREAS, Viola Ford Fletcher is the oldest living witness of the 1921 Tulsa race
18	massacre, and she is most deserving of the highest recognition for her incredible resilience
9	and for her continued efforts to preserve the legacy of Black Wall Street.
