AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 2, line 3, after "**R.S. 37:1262,**" delete "**who is**"

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, at the beginning of line 10, after "**a**" and before "**law**" insert "**tactical**" and after "**enforcement**" change "**agency**" to "**unit**"

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, line 15, after "**to a**" insert "**tactical**"

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 2, at the beginning of line 16, change "**tactical team**" to "**unit**"

AMENDMENT NO. 5

On page 2, line 26, change "**law enforcement agency**" to "**tactical law enforcement unit**"

AMENDMENT NO. 6

On page 2, at the beginning of line 28, after "**he**" delete "**or she**" and at the end of the line after "**himself**" delete "**or herself**"

AMENDMENT NO. 7

On page 3, at the end of line 2, after "**enforcement**" add "**unit**"

AMENDMENT NO. 8

On page 3, line 3, after "**his**" delete "**or her**"

AMENDMENT NO. 9

On page 3, line 19, after "requirements" change "must" to "**shall**"

AMENDMENT NO. 10

On page 3, line 23, after "**for**" change "**reserve and auxiliary peace**" to "**auxiliary**"

AMENDMENT NO. 11

On page 3, at the beginning of line 25. after "**A.**" insert "**(1)**" and change "**a reserve or auxiliary peace**" to "**an auxiliary**"

AMENDMENT NO. 12

On page 3, line 27, after "**council.**" delete the remainder of the line, delete line 28, and insert the following:

"The maximum number of hours required for auxiliary officer training under this Section shall not exceed one hundred twenty hours. The auxiliary officer

1 shall pass an examination approved by the council within one calendar year of
2 initial service with a law enforcement agency.

3 (2) This curriculum shall be created by the council with courses
4 including but not limited to legal definitions, stop and frisk, Miranda rights,
5 arrests, elements of probable cause determinations, firearm training, officer
6 survival skills, de-escalation strategies, use of force, cardiopulmonary
7 resuscitation, and first aid. This curriculum may be taught at the auxiliary
8 officer's affiliated law enforcement agency by a P.O.S.T. certified trainer.

9 (3) For the purpose of this Chapter, "auxiliary officer" means an
10 individual who has volunteered his service to a law enforcement agency to assist
11 in preserving public safety and has been certified as an auxiliary officer by the
12 council. An auxiliary officer shall serve under the supervision of a P.O.S.T.
13 certified peace officer.

14 (4) The responsibilities of an auxiliary officer may include duties such as
15 event security and traffic direction, including but not limited to funeral
16 processions, athletic contests and sporting events, parades, festivals, or other
17 similar activities, as supplemental or additional personnel. An auxiliary officer
18 may not effect an arrest, issue citations, or conduct searches and seizures unless
19 he is under the direct supervision of a P.O.S.T. certified peace officer."
