SPECIAL DAY/WEEK/MONTH: Recognizes May 15, 2025, as Necrotizing Enterocolitis Awareness Day in Louisiana

A RESOLUTION

| 2 | To recognize Thursday, May 15, 2025, as Necrotizing Enterocolitis Awareness Day in the |
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| 3 | state of Louisiana. |
| 4 | WHEREAS, necrotizing enterocolitis (NEC) is an intestinal disease that primarily |
| 5 | affects premature and medically fragile infants; the disease causes a severe inflammatory |
| 6 | process that can lead to intestinal tissue damage and is the most common cause of death in |
| 7 | hospitalized premature infants after two weeks of age; and |
| 8 | WHEREAS, babies born prematurely or with a medical complication, like congenital |
| 9 | heart disease, are most at risk of NEC; thousands of babies develop NEC each year and |
| 10 | hundreds of babies die from this complex intestinal condition; many babies only live for a |
| 11 | few hours or days after NEC is diagnosed; and |
| 12 | WHEREAS, surgery for NEC is not curative, and babies who survive often have |
| 13 | lifelong neurological and nutritional complications; and |
| 14 | WHEREAS, NEC results in approximately \$5 trillion of hospitalization expenses per |
| 15 | year and roughly nineteen percent of neonatal healthcare expenditures in the United States, |
| 16 | with an estimated cost of \$200,000 or more for each case of surgical necrotizing |
| 17 | enterocolitis; and |
| 18 | WHEREAS, although the risk of necrotizing enterocolitis cannot be fully eliminated, |
| 19 | preventative measures are effective at reducing risks; feeding breast milk is one of the most |
| 20 | effective ways to help prevent necrotizing enterocolitis in medically fragile infants; and |

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1 WHEREAS, more data is desperately needed to better understand how and why NEC 2 occurs in infants; and 3 WHEREAS, because of disparities and variation in care, black infants are 4 disproportionately affected by NEC compared to white infants; and 5 WHEREAS, to build a world without necrotizing enterocolitis and improve outcomes 6 for infants and families, we must raise awareness about this devastating neonatal disease. 7 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the 8 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby recognize Thursday, May 15, 2025, as Necrotizing 9 Enterocolitis Awareness Day in Louisiana and does hereby recognize the importance of
