A RESOLUTION

2	To designate May 2025 as ALS Awareness Month in Louisiana.
3	WHEREAS, Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS), also known as Lou Gehrig's
4	Disease, is a progressive neurodegenerative disease that affects nerve cells in the brain and
5	spinal cord, leading to the loss of muscle control; and
6	WHEREAS, approximately 30,000 Americans are living with ALS at any given time,
7	with an estimated 5,000 new diagnoses each year, impacting individuals and families across
8	Louisiana and the nation; and
9	WHEREAS, ALS has no known cure, and the average life expectancy after diagnosis
10	is two to five years, underscoring the urgent need for increased research, treatment options,
11	and critical support services; and
12	WHEREAS, raising public awareness about ALS fosters greater understanding,
13	encourages early diagnosis, and supports advocacy for those affected, including patients,
14	caregivers, and families; and
15	WHEREAS, May is recognized nationally as ALS Awareness Month, providing an
16	opportunity to honor those living with ALS, remember those who have passed, and support
17	efforts to find treatments or a cure; and
18	WHEREAS, the state of Louisiana is committed to promoting the health and
19	well-being of its citizens and supporting initiatives that address the challenges faced by
20	individuals with ALS.
