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Provides for mental health screenings in schools. (8/1/25)

Proposed legislation provides a framework for a city, parish, or other local school system to provide mental health screenings for all kindergarten through grade 12 students during the first semester of each academic year. Provides that the Louisiana Department of Health (LDH) is to develop a list of mental health screening tools and community resources and to provide this information to the Louisiana Department of Education (LDOE) for distribution to local school systems. Provides for confidentiality and destruction of testing results and prohibits schools from using the results to make decisions concerning student instruction and discipline.

At the time of publication of this fiscal note, LDH can develop and provide the information required of them by proposed legislation by existing employees within their current scope of work.
