<u>Proposed law</u> requires the La. Dept. of Health to develop and provide certain type 1 diabetes information to the Dept. of Education.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the Dept. of Education to provide the information to each city, parish, and local public school board.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires a recommendation that a parent or legal guardian of a student displaying warning signs with type 1 diabetes or positive early detection screening results should immediately consult the primary care doctor to develop a treatment plan.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the school boards to distribute the information to parents and legal guardians of all prekindergarten and K-12 students upon enrollment and annually thereafter by posting on school websites or by electronic distribution.

Effective August 1, 2025.
