Amendments proposed by House Committee on Administration of Criminal Justice to Original House Bill No. 220 by Representative Willard

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, line 9, after "<u>firearm</u>" delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 10 and 11
in their entirety and insert the following:

⁴ "occurs when a person leaves a loaded firearm within a dwelling or vehicle, when
⁵ that person knows or reasonably should know that a minor child is likely to gain
⁶ access to the firearm without the lawful permission of the minor child's parent or the
⁷ person having charge of the minor child, and when the minor child obtains
⁸ possession of such firearm and then does either of the following:"

- 10 On page 1, delete lines 13 and 14 in their entirety and insert the following:
- 11 "(2) Exhibits the firearm in a public place."
- 12 AMENDMENT NO. 3
- 13 On page 2, line 2, after "<u>obtains</u>" and before "<u>access</u>" delete "<u>supervised</u>"
- 14 AMENDMENT NO. 4
- 15 On page 2, between lines 3 and 4, insert the following:
- 16 "(3) When a person is carrying a firearm on his person.

17 (4) When a person secures the firearm with a trigger lock or stores the
 18 firearm in a securely locked box or container which a reasonable person would
 19 believe to be secure."

- 20 AMENDMENT NO. 5
- 21 On page 2, after line 7, add the following:

22	"E. No peace officer nor any other person shall arrest a person for a violation
23	of this Section before the seventh day following the date on which the offense is
24	alleged to have been committed if both of the following circumstances exist:
25	(1) The offender is a member of the family of the child who discharged the
26	firearm.
27	(2) The child has caused death or serious injury to himself through discharge
28	of the firearm."
