HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 204

TAX/CORP FRANCHISE: Urges and requests that the legislature establish the Louisiana Auto Manufacturing Fund

A RESOLUTION
To urge and request the Department of Transportation and Development study and take
action on establishing the Louisiana Auto Manufacturing Fund to support the
development and production of automobiles.
WHEREAS, the funds invested in automobile manufacturers are designed to generate
high returns and long term investments; and
WHEREAS, Louisiana has many advantages to make it a competitive location for
automobile manufacturing, including workforce growth, low utility rates, and business
climates; and
WHEREAS, the Louisiana Auto Manufacturing Fund would make Louisiana a
preeminent leader in the automobile manufacturing space by providing direct financial
assistance by setting aside large sums of money for future highly competitive projects; and
WHEREAS, to keep talent in Louisiana it is imperative that Louisiana fund technical
community colleges that have automotive programs to provide high-level skill sets for the
automobile industry workforce; and
WHEREAS, fifty million dollars was supplied to six states with significant
automotive workforces to help small and medium sized suppliers adapt; and
WHEREAS, a Louisiana Automobile Manufacturing Fund would attract more
reputable automakers and automobile part distributions sites to Louisiana; and
WHEREAS, the General Motors plant in Arlington, Texas is the company's only
remaining United States plant building full-sized SUV's; and

1	WHEREAS, the Shreveport Assembly and Stamping Plant was a General Motors
2	vehicle factory; and
3	WHEREAS, the 3,100,000 square foot factory opened in 1981 and produced over 4.8
4	million vehicles; and
5	WHEREAS, at its peak, it provided over four thousand jobs with an annual payroll
6	of \$160 million dollars, and \$4.5 million in annual tax revenue; and
7	WHEREAS, over \$1.5 billion was invested into the Shreveport facility, which
8	expanded in 2002 resulting in a new stamping facility; and
9	WHEREAS, the plant closed in August 2012 due to a systemwide production
10	shortage; and
11	WHEREAS, redeveloping and positioning the property for future investments is
12	essential for growth; and
13	WHEREAS, the Louisiana Auto Manufacturing Fund would positively benefit the
14	economy and citizens.
15	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
16	Legislature of Louisiana does hereby urge and request the Department of Transportation and
17	Development to study and to take measures to create the Louisiana Auto Manufacturing
18	Fund to maximize investment opportunities.
19	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation and
20	Development shall submit a report summarizing its findings, on the benefits of creating the
21	Louisiana Automobile Manufacturing Fund to support the development and production of
22	automobiles, to the House Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public Works by
23	August 1, 2026.
24	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the

25 secretary of the Department of Transportation and Development.
