SPECIAL DAY/WEEK/MONTH: Designates May 27, 2025, as Louisiana Music Advocacy Day at the state capitol

1 A RESOLUTION

2 To designate Tuesday, May 27, 2025, as Louisiana Music Advocacy Day at the state capitol.

3 WHEREAS, music and music creators are Louisiana's greatest renewable natural  
4 resource; and

5 WHEREAS, Louisiana is the birthplace of many unique musical styles, such as jazz,  
6 blues, zydeco, swamp pop, rock and roll, gospel, country, bounce, rhythm and blues, and  
7 Cajun music; and

8 WHEREAS, Louisiana musicians continue to be leaders in the entertainment industry  
9 capturing prestigious awards and developing innovative new sounds that continue to build  
10 the Louisiana brand as the most musical place on the planet; and

11 WHEREAS, the music industry in Louisiana contributes \$1.4 billion to the state's  
12 GDP, employing over 30,000 Louisiana citizens, yet the state has not fully developed the  
13 infrastructure of goods and services to support its artists; and

14 WHEREAS, the Louisiana music industry has reached a new level of  
15 internationalization and opportunity, and the state has numerous postsecondary education  
16 institutions devoted to educating future music creators and music industry professionals; and

17 WHEREAS, recognizing this economic importance and incentivizing growth in  
18 Louisiana's music industry support system for developing music industry careers is vital for  
19 our current and future music creators and the economy of Louisiana.

20 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the  
21 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby designate Tuesday, May 27, 2025, as Louisiana Music

1 Advocacy Day at the state capitol; does hereby recognize the opportunities for growth in the  
2 music industry; and does hereby extend enduring appreciation to all music creators in the  
3 state.
