2	To express the sincere and heartfelt condolences of the Legislature of Louisiana upon the
3	death of Steven Joseph Miguez and to recognize and commend his life of service,
4	entrepreneurship, and devotion to family and community.
5	WHEREAS, it is with deep regret and profound sorrow that the Legislature of
6	Louisiana has learned of the passing of Steven Joseph Miguez on February 24, 2025, at the
7	age of seventy-one; and
8	WHEREAS, Steven J. Miguez was a loving husband, devoted father and grandfather,
9	and a respected businessman who contributed significantly to the economic vitality and
10	cultural richness of Iberia Parish and the state of Louisiana; and
11	WHEREAS, born on November 2, 1953, Steve was a graduate of Catholic High
12	School, class of 1972, and attended the University of Southwestern Louisiana from 1972
13	through 1975; and
14	WHEREAS, through hard work and vision, he founded Iberia Crew Boat & Marine
15	Service in 1975, which now operates thirteen offshore vessels in partnership with Seatran
16	Marine and continues to support Louisiana's vital maritime industry; and
17	WHEREAS, in 1992, Steve founded Miguez Fuel and Lubricants, serving as
18	president and leading the company to become an authorized distributor of Phillips 66

lubricants with locations in New Iberia and Baton Rouge; and 1 WHEREAS, beyond his business acumen, Steve was a master-level competitive 2 3 pistol shooter, competing nationally and internationally, including representing the United States in multiple World Shoot events, earning silver and bronze medals with the Senior 4 Standard Team; and 5 6 WHEREAS, Steve was a passionate supporter of the shooting sports, a lifetime 7 member of the National Rifle Association, a benefactor of the United States Practical 8 Shooting Association, a past president of the Cajun Action Shooters Club, and a reserve 9 deputy in the Iberia Parish Sheriff's Department; and 10 WHEREAS, he was a man of diverse interests, enjoying wine making, cooking, 11 hunting, fishing, traveling, and especially spending time with his wife Glenda and their 12 family, including traveling the world to support his son Blake's competitive shooting career; 13 and 14 WHEREAS, Steve's memory and influence will live on through his beloved wife of 15 forty-eight years, Glenda; his sons, Blake and Ridge; his grandchildren, Julianna, Izabel, and Colin; his siblings, and a wide circle of extended family, friends, and community members; 16 17 and 18 WHEREAS, Steven Joseph Miguez leaves behind a legacy of hard work, excellence, 19 generosity, and love, and his memory will forever be honored by those whose lives he 20 touched. 21 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby extend its sincere and heartfelt condolences to the family and friends of Steven Joseph 22 23 Miguez and does hereby recognize and celebrate his remarkable life, professional 24 achievements, and personal legacy. 25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
