Directs the La. State Law Institute to conduct data collection of the justice of the peace and city courts in the state of La., including their jurisdiction, the costs and savings for their operations, and to report to the legislature no later than Feb. 1, 2026.

#### Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Judiciary to the original resolution:

1. Remove references relative to abolishing the courts.
2. Specify collecting data regarding methods of funding and expenditures.
3. Change directions to the La. State Law Institute to provide a report rather than to provide recommendations.
