A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To commend and congratulate Sam Houston High School's Lady Broncos for their phenomenal season and for capturing the Louisiana High School Athletic Association (LHSAA) Softball Non-Select Division I State Championship in dramatic and inspiring fashion.

WHEREAS, on May 3, 2025, the No. 1-seeded Sam Houston Lady Broncos battled through extra innings to defeat No. 4 St. Amant 5-3, in a thrilling semifinal showdown that kept fans on the edge of their seats; and

WHEREAS, facing elimination in the bottom of the seventh inning, Kailyn Mire delivered a clutch two-run home run to tie the game, followed by Kallie England, who launched a go-ahead two-run homer in the bottom of the eighth to seal the win and propel the Lady Broncos into the championship game; and

WHEREAS, on May 4, 2025, the Lady Broncos completed their championship quest with a heart-pounding 3-2 victory over No. 3 Dutchtown in the title game, showcasing grit, determination, and championship-caliber execution; and

WHEREAS, Taelyn Droddy came through in the clutch with a late-inning RBI single that secured the winning run and clinched Sam Houston High School's first state title since 2015; and

WHEREAS, pitcher Kailyn Mire was a force throughout the tournament, earning the win in both games and being named the Most Outstanding Player of the state tournament for her outstanding performance under pressure; and

WHEREAS, this historic victory was the culmination of an extraordinary team effort by players Mazlin Authement (#00), Rayleigh Blanchard (#8), Bailey Collins (#20), Addyson Domingue (#16), Taelyn Droddy (#26), Kallie England (#7), Carolina Eidson (#21), Addison Ellis (#19), Kara Fruge (#25), Drew Hyatt (#2), Aubrey Hobbs (#13), Layla Landry (#22), Kailyn Mire (#18), Chloe Peshoff (#12), and Aubrey Portie (#5), each of whom contributed to a season filled with unforgettable moments; and

WHEREAS, Head Coach Beth Domingue led the Lady Broncos with excellence, capturing her fifth state title as head coach and delivering the program's sixth overall championship, ably supported by assistant coaches Casidy Chaumont, Andrew Guillotte, Kayla Hamilton, Jonathon Heflin, and Jaquelyn Ramon; and

WHEREAS, with a remarkable season record of thirty wins and only two losses, the Lady Broncos exemplified the mission of Sam Houston High School to provide "meaningful learning experiences for all students" through their teamwork, resilience, and championship spirit.
