1 A RESOLUTION

2 To express sincere and heartfelt condolences of the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana
3 to the family of Jackie "Jack" Rollin Lamb upon the occasion of his passing and to
4 celebrate a lifetime of service, creativity, and devotion to family, faith, and
5 community.

6 WHEREAS, born on May 12, 1939, in Taylor, Arkansas, Jackie "Jack" Rollin Lamb
7 passed away on May 15, 2025, at the age of eighty-six; and

8 WHEREAS, the son of Rollin Samuel Lamb and Helen McDonald Lamb, Jack spent
9 his early years in Pensacola, Florida, before the family settled in Shreveport, Louisiana,
10 where his sister Inez received care at Shriners Children's Hospital, instilling in him a lifelong
11 admiration for the Shriners' mission; and

12 WHEREAS, a proud graduate of C.E. Byrd High School, Jack honorably served his
13 country in the United States Marine Corps exemplifying the values of duty, discipline, and
14 patriotism; and

15 WHEREAS, Jack married the love of his life, Georgiann Chandler, in 1957 at First
16 Methodist Church in Waskom, Texas, and together the couple built a loving home in
17 Shreveport, raising four children and nurturing a legacy defined by deep faith, strong values,
18 and enduring love; and

1 WHEREAS, a man of entrepreneurial spirit and boundless creativity, Jack was
2 founder and operator of Lamb Advertising Specialties and Lamb Outdoor Advertising,
3 where his talent for storytelling, design, and memorable slogans left a lasting mark on the
4 business and cultural landscape of the Shreveport-Bossier community; and

5 WHEREAS, Jack's innovative and humorous personality is best illustrated by the
6 installation of a nine-foot-tall rooster statue on a corner in downtown Shreveport; a
7 whimsical and unexpected gift to the city that reflected his offbeat charm and flair for the
8 unforgettable; and

9 WHEREAS, a lifelong member of First Methodist Church in Shreveport, Jack found
10 joy and fellowship in the Seekers class, and his passion for flying led to a lifetime
11 membership in The Quiet Birdmen; a distinguished fraternal organization of male aviators
12 founded by World War I pilots in 1921; and

13 WHEREAS, Jack was once best described as a person "with a sharp wit and a knack
14 for one-liners," who had a "way of dropping a memorable, quotable comment at just the right
15 moment – the kind that made you laugh out loud, or shake your head. He was quite a
16 character" saying just the right thing to leave a smile, or a headshake, in his wake; and

17 WHEREAS, preceded in death by his beloved wife, Georgiann Chandler Lamb; his
18 parents; his mother-in-law, Georgie Harman Chandler; and his daughter-in-law, Amy Harris
19 Lamb; Jack is survived by his loving family: daughter, Ann Lamb Tolleson; sons, Walter
20 Lamb (Tamara), Richard Lamb (Kathy), and Patrick Lamb; his grandchildren, Laura
21 Tolleson Long (Daniel), Christopher Tolleson, Morgan Tolleson, Sam Tolleson (Andrea),
22 Michael Ross Lamb, Emmy Lamb Hudson (Tyler), Rich Lamb (Ginny), Spencer Lamb
23 (Allison), Christian Lamb (Michelle), Kappy Lamb, Betsy Lamb Samuels (Jason), Mary
24 Patrick Lamb Goodyear (Mitchell), and Alex Lamb; great-grandchildren, Prudence Long,
25 Miles Tolleson, Miles Ross Lamb, Tallulah Hudson, Virginia, Chip, and Nancy Lamb,

30 generosity, and his presence will be dearly missed by all who were privileged to know him.
