SPECIAL DAY/WEEK/MONTH. Designates Tuesday, May 27, 2025, as Louisiana Community Health Center Day at the Louisiana State Capitol.

1	A RESOLUTION
2	To designate Tuesday, May 27, 2025, as Louisiana Community Health Center Day at the
3	Louisiana State Capitol and to commend the Louisiana Primary Care Association
4	and Louisiana's community health centers for their continued commitment to
5	providing high quality, cost effective health care to underserved communities in
6	Louisiana.
7	WHEREAS, the Louisiana Primary Care Association (LPCA) was established in
8	1982 as a nonprofit organization and the trade association for all the Federally Qualified
9	Health Centers (FQHCs) throughout Louisiana; and
10	WHEREAS, this association has been providing primary care services inclusive of
11	dental and behavioral service to the uninsured and underserved populations throughout the
12	entire state of Louisiana stressing the importance of healthcare access as the foundation to
13	building healthcare communities; and
14	WHEREAS, LPCA is a membership organization of forty-one community health
15	centers operating over four hundred seventy individual sites and is governed by a six-person
16	executive committee, a forty-one person board of directors, and staffed by twenty-one
17	employees committed to the goal of achieving healthcare access to all Louisiana
18	citizens; and

1	WHEREAS, these community-based health center sites have delivered care over the
2	past year to over 503,000 patients with over 2,000,000 visits; and
3	WHEREAS, through providing innovative and cost-efficient care Louisiana's
4	community health centers have the ability to maintain the highest standard in quality and
5	patient satisfaction; and
6	WHEREAS, this network of providers has a tremendous economic impact in
7	Louisiana by creating over 8,800 jobs, generating \$153 million in tax revenue, and spending
8	\$798 million; and
9	WHEREAS, this FQHC model of care delivery has led to \$964 million in savings
10	to the healthcare system and \$703 million savings to the Medicaid program as well as
11	generated \$29 million in local, state, and federal tax revenues; and
12	WHEREAS, the community health centers emphasize wellness and preventative care
13	and offer screening for cervical and colorectal cancer, weight assessment and screening,
14	tobacco cessation, and immunizations, as well as placing a special emphasis on
15	comprehensive care management of chronic diseases; and
16	WHEREAS, these healthcare facilities are woven deeply into the fabric of their
17	communities and participate in outreach and communication efforts striving to eliminate the
18	disparities in care associated with patient race, ethnicity, or socioeconomic status.
19	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana
20	does hereby designate Tuesday, May 27, 2025, as Louisiana Community Health Center Day
21	at the Louisiana State Capitol and does hereby commend the Louisiana Primary Care
22	Association and its community health center members for over forty years of providing care
23	to Louisiana citizens.

25	Louisiana Primary Care Association.
