- On page 1, at the beginning of line 6, delete "46(C)(3) and (4)"
- 6 AMENDMENT NO. 3
- 7 On page 2, line 5, after "(113)" and the comma "," and before "47" insert "46(E),"
- 8 AMENDMENT NO. 4
- 9 On page 3, line 1, after "zones" and before "lawfully" insert "parks, playgrounds, and any
- 10 other recreation areas"
- 11 AMENDMENT NO. 5
- On page 3, line 2, after the period "." delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 4 and
- 13 5 in their entirety and insert the following:
- "An unmanned automated speed enforcement device shall not be used to issue speeding citations in a school zone <u>or near parks</u>, <u>playgrounds</u>, <u>and any other recreation areas</u> when a driver is not exceeding the posted speed limit immediately prior to <u>the school zone if school zone</u> <u>a location specified in this</u>
- 18 Paragraph if signs are not posted at the entrance and exit of the school zone
- 19 <u>location</u>."

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- 20 AMENDMENT NO. 6
- 21 On page 4, delete lines 17 through 22 in their entirety and insert the following:
- 22 "C. Local municipal authorities and local parish authorities shall only 23 operate electronic enforcement devices near parks, playgrounds, and any other 24 recreational areas from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
 - C.(1)D.(1) Revenue generated as a result of electronic enforcement devices in school zones shall be divided between the governing authority of the school where the traffic citation was issued and the municipality after the governing authority pays the contractor or vendor for the costs of providing the electronic enforcement devices and related services.
 - (2) A cooperative endeavor agreement executed by the municipality and each governing authority of the schools located within the municipality's boundaries shall be in place prior to <u>the</u> implementation of automated speed enforcement devices and mobile speed cameras.

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1	(3) Revenue generated within Orleans Parish outside of a school zone shall
2	only be used for the purposes of stormwater drainage infrastructure, maintenance,
3	and improvements.
4	(4) Revenue generated as a result of electronic enforcement devices outside
5	of a school zone shall only be used for public safety purposes.
6	D.(1)E.(1) Any jurisdiction that submits a local match waiver for capital
7	outlay shall disclose the amount of revenue collected from handheld traffic cameras
8	electronic enforcement devices. The failure to disclose the information required by
9	this Subsection shall result in any local match waiver being revoked.
10	(2) No local match waiver shall be revoked pursuant to this Subsection for
11	any of the following types of capital outlay projects:
12	(a) Water system projects.
13	(b) Sewer system projects.
14	(c) Natural gas system projects."
