2 To commend centenarian Elmo "Buddy" Sholes on his historic life and honorable service 3 to the United States during World War II. 4 WHEREAS, Elmo "Buddy" Sholes was born on December 26, 1920, in Wilson, 5 Louisiana, to Iree Sholes and Fannie Caston and was the youngest of five siblings; and 6 WHEREAS, Mr. Sholes was called upon to serve in the United States Army in 1941 7 and was stationed in the Philippines and the Pacific Islands; he rose to the rank of corporal 8 during his tenure with the Army, and upon returning home from the Pacific Theater, he was 9 stationed at a base in New Jersey; and 10 WHEREAS, Mr. Sholes married his hometown sweetheart, Trogia Eunice Goins, in 11 Newark, New Jersey, in 1943, and they lived in Newark for over twenty years before 12 returning to Louisiana; the couple had no children, but they helped raise numerous nieces 13 and nephews, and they shared sixty-six years of loving marriage before Mrs. Sholes passed 14 in 2009; and 15 WHEREAS, Mr. Sholes has been a dedicated servant of the Church of God in Christ 16 in Morganza, Louisiana, for over sixty-five years and has held numerous titles within the 17 church, including elder, pastor, and superintendent; he currently holds the title of 18 superintendent emeritus of the Louisiana East Second Ecclesiastical Jurisdiction; and 19 WHEREAS, Mr. Sholes was honored by Governor Jeff Landry and given the World War II Coin on Monday, May 5, 2025, and he is most deserving of the highest recognition 20 for his service to the United States. 21
