SPECIAL DAY/WEEK/MONTH. Designates May 29, 2025, as St. James Parish Day at the Louisiana State Capitol.

1	A RESOLUTION
2	To designate Thursday, May 29, 2025, as St. James Parish Day at the Louisiana State
3	Capitol.
4	WHEREAS, St. James Parish is one of the original nineteen parishes created on
5	March 31, 1807, by an act of the Orleans Territorial Legislature; prior to its creation as a
6	civil parish, the area formed a part of the "Comté d'Acadie" or Country of Acadia, which was
7	composed of the old ecclesiastical parishes of the St. James and "The Ascension"; and
8	WHEREAS, the region was the ancestral homeland of the Houma and the
9	Chitimacha Native American tribes; the first Acadian exiles settled in the area around 1762,
10	and the French and Spanish established permanent settlements around 1780; and
11	WHEREAS, the land of St. James Parish is chiefly alluvial with some wooded
12	lowlands and coastal marshes, and the streams and swamplands of the parish provide ample
13	opportunity for hunting and fishing; the parish is the only area that grows Perique tobacco,
14	a product that is highly demanded by large tobacco interests; and
15	WHEREAS, St. James Parish is deeply connected to the history of education in
16	Louisiana; Jefferson College, one of the best-known and oldest educational institutions in
17	the state, was founded in the parish in 1838 and operated as a state-supported, non-sectarian
18	institution until its closing in 1927; The Sacred Heart of Convent was founded in 1825 by

1	a colony of French nuns and has educated generation after generation of women in the
2	parish, including many from Mexico and Central America; and
3	WHEREAS, St. James Parish is the home of a number of historically prominent
4	Louisiana citizens, including former Louisiana governor, André Bienvenue Roman; French
5	Journalist, Dr. Pierre Lyon; pioneer in the sugar industry, Valcour Aime; former parish
6	sheriff and minister to Haiti, Louis LeBourgeois; and many others; and
7	WHEREAS, St. James Parish is a truly remarkable region that is known for its rich
8	culture, abundance of industries, and staunch support of family-owned small-businesses, and
9	the parish is most deserving of the highest recognition for it's contributions to the cultural
10	atmosphere of the state.
11	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana
12	does hereby designate Thursday, May 29, 2025, as St. James Parish Day at the Louisiana
13	State Capitol and does hereby express enduring appreciation to the parish and its residents
14	for their contributions to the state of Louisiana.
