1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 37:2418(F)(1) and (2), relative to the practice of physical
3	therapist assistants; to provide for the supervision of physical therapist assistants and
4	unlicensed supportive personnel; to repeal the requirement for documented
5	conferences between a physical therapist and a physical therapist assistant; to
6	provide for the treatment and reassessment of patients; and to provide for related
7	matters.
8	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
9	Section 1. R.S. 37:2418(F)(1) and (2) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as
10	follows:
11	§2418. Authority to practice as a physical therapist or physical therapist assistant
12	* * *
13	F.(1) A person licensed under pursuant to this Chapter as a physical therapist
14	assistant shall perform treatments only under the direction and supervision of a
15	licensed physical therapist. The duties assigned to the physical therapist assistant
16	shall be commensurate with the physical therapist assistant's education, training, and
17	experience.
18	(2) Notwithstanding any provision of law or rule to the contrary, the
19	supervision requirements of a physical therapist assistant shall only be the following:
20	(a) It is the responsibility of each physical therapist to determine the number
21	of physical therapist assistants therapy supportive personnel he can supervise safely;
22	however, in no case shall the number of individuals supervised by a physical
23	therapist exceed five six individuals., nor exceed the following limitations as to
24	supervised personnel:
25	(i) No more than four physical therapist assistants or technicians or any
26	combination thereof.

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1	(ii) No more than two provisional licensees.
2	(iii) No more than five students.
3	(b) A supervising physical therapist is responsible for and shall participate
4	in the patient's care.
5	(c) A supervising physical therapist shall be readily accessible by beeper or
6	telephone telecommunication and available to the patient by the next scheduled
7	treatment session upon request of the patient or physical therapist assistant.
8	(d) A physical therapist assistant's duties shall not include interpretation or
9	implementation of referrals or prescriptions, performance of evaluations, or the
10	determination or major modification of treatment programs.
11	(e) A supervising physical therapist shall hold documented conferences with
12	the physical therapist assistant regarding the patient. The physical therapist is
13	responsible for determining the frequency of the conferences consistent with
14	accepted standards of practice; however, such conferences shall occur at least every
15	sixth treatment day or every thirty days, whichever occurs first.
16	(f) A supervising physical therapist shall treat and reassess the patient at least
17	every sixth twelfth treatment day or every thirty days, whichever occurs first and for
18	his final treatment session, when feasible.
19	(g) A supervising physical therapist shall treat the patient for his final
20	treatment session when feasible and write a discharge summary.
