CIVIL/LAW: Provides relative to the freedom to display the flag of the United States.

DIGEST

Proposed law provides that no planned community, condominium association, or lessor shall adopt or enforce any provision outlawing or restricting an individual from displaying a removable, portable flag of the United States.

Proposed law provides that nothing in proposed law shall prevent a planned community, condominium association, or lessor from adopting or enforcing reasonable provisions as to the size, time, place, and manner of displaying the flag of the United States.

Proposed law provides for injunctive relief, court costs, and reasonable attorney fees when a violation of proposed law occurs.
