A RESOLUTION

To commend and congratulate the St. Louis Catholic High School Boys Golf Team for winning the 2025 Louisiana High School Athletic Association (LHSAA) Division II State Championship and to recognize junior Kye Hanks for capturing the individual state title.

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Senate takes great pride in honoring the accomplishments of Louisiana's outstanding student-athletes and athletic programs; and

WHEREAS, the St. Louis Catholic High School Boys Golf Team of Lake Charles, Louisiana, claimed the 2025 LHSAA Division II State Championship, their second team title in three years, in a weather-shortened tournament held at The Farm d'Allie Golf Club in Carencro; and

WHEREAS, the Saints displayed remarkable composure and talent in challenging conditions, finishing with a team total score of 457 (+25) over 27 holes; and

WHEREAS, junior Kye Hanks delivered a stellar individual performance, carding a 69 (-3) on day one and a 37 (+1) on the final nine holes, for a total score of 106 (-2), securing the individual state title; and

WHEREAS, the team showed outstanding depth with strong contributions from all players:

- Samuel Broussard, 3rd place overall (76-39-115)
- Kane Hanks, 4th place overall (76-40-116)
- Evan Comeaux, tied for 9th (81-40-121)
- Luke LeBeouf, tied for 9th (80-41-121); and

WHEREAS, the Saints' collective performance and perseverance are a testament to their work ethic, discipline, and unity both on and off the course; and

WHEREAS, the achievements of the St. Louis Catholic High School Boys Golf Team have brought tremendous pride and recognition to their school, their families, and the entire Lake Charles community.
