4	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
5	Section 1. R.S. 14:100(C)(2) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
6	§100. Hit-and-run driving

0	(2) Whoever commits the crime of hit-and-run driving, when death or
1	serious bodily injury is a direct result of the accident, and when the driver knew or
12	should have known that death or serious bodily injury has occurred, and the driver's
13	vehicle was directly involved in the accident, shall be fined not more than five
14	thousand dollars or imprisoned with or without hard labor for not <u>less than two years</u>
15	nor more than ten years, two of which shall be served without the benefit of parole,
16	probation, or suspension of sentence, or both.
