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## MEDICAID

**RE1 SEE FISC NOTE GF EX** 

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Provides relative to third-party liability, claim adjudication, and timeliness of such within the state medical assistance program

<u>Proposed law</u> provides relative to third-party liability to the state medical assistance program. To provide for Managed Care Organization (MCO) claim payment information; to provide information relative to third-party liability; to require notification regarding insurance information; and to provide penalties for violations.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that LDH shall withhold payment to the MCO in an amount determined by the department, not less than \$25,000 or greater for each violation by an MCO. If an MCO has committed multiple violations, the minimum amount shall be at least \$100,000.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that implementation of the provisions of R.S. 46:460.76.3 (Claim Information; third party liability) shall begin on August 1, 2025.

## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

Proposed measure prohibits MCOs from amending, modifying, or changing a claim submitted by a healthcare provider or adjusting, down coding, or paying a claim at a lower level than what was submitted by the healthcare provider. To the extent MCOs violate these provisions, LDH shall withhold payment to the MCO an amount to be determined by LDH not less than \$25,000 or greater for each violation.
