A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To urge and request the Louisiana High School Athletic Association (LHSAA) to refrain from hosting games during Easter weekend.

WHEREAS, in Louisiana, many families, including those with high school athletes, observe Good Friday, Holy Saturday, and Easter Sunday; and

WHEREAS, while high school athletics are of great importance to those who participate, pausing to observe the holy weekend is important as well; and

WHEREAS, student athletes are disciplined and dedicated and train often; they are much deserving of uninterrupted time with their families and friends; it is unnecessary to force student athletes and their loved ones to choose between an athletic event and observing the end of the Lenten season.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby urge and request LHSAA to refrain from hosting games during Easter weekend.
