SPECIAL DAY/WEEK/MONTH: Designates June 2-6, 2025, as CPR and AED Awareness Week in Louisiana and commends Caroline Ross, Layton Fontenot, and Hayes Kirkpatrick for their heroic acts and commitment to the well-being of others

A RESOLUTION

2	To designate June 2-6, 2025, as CPR and AED Awareness Week in Louisiana and to
3	commend Caroline Ross, Layton Fontenot, and Hayes Kirkpatrick for their heroic
4	acts and commitment to the well-being of others.
5	WHEREAS, the safety and well-being of all individuals in and around aquatic and
6	recreational facilities are of paramount importance; and
7	WHEREAS, on May 24, 2025, a medical emergency occurred on the tennis courts
8	at Bocage Racquet Club in Baton Rouge, adjacent to a swimming pool guarded by
9	lifeguards; and
10	WHEREAS, Caroline Ross, a bystander present on the tennis courts, immediately
11	recognized the emergency, summoned assistance, and retrieved the Automated External
12	Defibrillator (AED), initiating the chain of survival; and
13	WHEREAS, Layton Fontenot and Hayes Kirkpatrick, both certified American Red
14	Cross lifeguards employed by SELA Aquatics, promptly responded to the scene and
15	provided multiple-rescuer cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR), including chest
16	compression, rescue ventilation, and AED defibrillation; and
17	WHEREAS, the actions of Caroline Ross, Layton Fontenot, and Hayes Kirkpatrick
18	demonstrate exemplary courage, quick thinking, and teamwork under pressure, reflecting
19	the highest standards of emergency response and public service; and

1	WHEREAS, Mr. Fontenot is a recent graduate Catholic High School in Baton Rouge,
2	preparing to attend Louisiana State University in the fall of 2025, and Mr. Kirkpatrick is a
3	rising sophomore at Catholic High School; and
4	WHEREAS, this incident took place on Mr. Kirkpatrick's first day on the job, and
5	it stands as a testament to the critical importance of CPR and AED training, and the
6	readiness of even our youngest citizens to serve as lifesavers in moments of crisis; and
7	WHEREAS, summer brings the joy of family vacations, outdoor adventures, and
8	recreational activities, but it also means children are often away from teachers, coaches, and
9	caregivers trained in CPR, making it vital for parents and guardians to be prepared to
10	respond in an emergency; and
11	WHEREAS, June 1-7, 2025, is designated by the American Heart Association as
12	National CPR and AED Awareness Week, and the organization calls on families to "Be
13	Ready" and ensure that this summer is not only fun but safe by learning CPR and becoming
14	a part of the Nation of Lifesavers; and
15	WHEREAS, Hands-Only CPR can save the life of a teen or adult, while CPR with
16	breaths is recommended for infants and children, making it crucial that all individuals
17	understand the appropriate method of care for all age groups; and
18	WHEREAS, CPR saves lives, and everyone has the power to be a vital link in the
19	chain of survival by learning this life-saving skill; and
20	WHEREAS, an automated external defibrillator, or AED, is an easy-to-use medical
21	device that can restore a normal heart rhythm to someone who has gone into cardiac arrest;
22	and
23	WHEREAS, the Legislature of Louisiana has supported the inclusion of AEDs in
24	schools and athletic facilities across the state and has provided resources for expanding CPR
25	and AED training; and
26	WHEREAS, the American Heart Association invites everyone to join the Nation of
27	Lifesavers by visiting heart.org/nation, learning CPR, and supporting public policies to
28	increase survival from cardiac arrest.
29	THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Louisiana House of Representatives does
30	hereby proclaim June 2-6, 2025, as CPR and AED Awareness Week in Louisiana; does
