

1 limited to comparisons with the rules and regulations of other states; the authority of the
2 governor in other states to review and eliminate rules and regulations; the involvement of
3 the public with regard to the adoption, amendment, and repeal of rules and regulations and
4 ways to improve public participation in the process; the exercise of legislative oversight in
5 other states; and mechanisms to quantify the costs of proposed rules and regulations.

6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the special House committee shall be named the
7 "Special House Committee on Regulatory Reform" and shall be composed of six members
8 of the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives,
9 one of whom shall be designated by the speaker as the chairman of the committee.

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Speaker of the House of Representatives
11 shall designate staff to assist the committee in its work.

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Special House Committee on Regulatory
13 Reform shall report its findings to the legislature prior to February 16, 2026.
