## HB 310 2025 Regular Session Zeringue

COURTS: Provides relative to filings in civil and criminal courts

## **Synopsis of Senate Amendments**

- 1. Provides that all civil and criminal filings made by an attorney shall be filed either in person in paper form or electronically with the clerk of court.
- 2. Provides that an original testament may be submitted by certified mail or commercial courier for retention by the clerk of court as provided by <u>present</u> law.

## Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

<u>Present law</u> provides that all civil and criminal filings made by an attorney shall be filed electronically with the clerk of court.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and provides that all civil and criminal filing made by an attorney shall be filed either in person in paper form or electronically with clerk of court.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that an original testament may be submitted by certified mail or commercial courier for retention by the clerk of court as provided by C.C.P. Art. 2911.
