1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 11:610, relative to retired commissioned officers; to authorize certain
3	commissioned officers employed by the Department of Agriculture and Forestry to
4	purchase their service firearms upon retirement; to provide for certain criteria; to
5	provide an effective date; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 11:610 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
8	§610. Retirement; purchase of service firearm
9	Any member of the Louisiana State Employees' Retirement System who is
10	a commissioned officer employed by the Department of Agriculture and Forestry
11	pursuant to R.S. 3:734 or 4274.1, who has at least ten years of active service, and
12	who retires under the provisions of R.S. 11:441 shall be entitled to purchase his
13	service firearm at fair market value upon retirement, subject to the approval of the
14	commissioner of agriculture and forestry.
15	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
16	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
17	by the governor, as provided in Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
18	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
19	effective on the day following such approval.
