A RESOLUTION

2 To express the condolences of the House of Representatives upon the death of Charles B. 3 "Charlie" Rangel. 4 WHEREAS, it is with immense sadness and profound regret that the House of 5 Representatives of the Legislature of Louisiana has learned of the passing, on May 26, 2025, 6 of Charles B. "Charlie" Rangel; and 7 WHEREAS, Charles B. "Charlie" Rangel was born on June 11, 1930, in the Harlem 8 neighborhood of Upper Manhattan; he enlisted in the United States Army and served during 9 the Korean War, earning a Bronze Star for valor and Purple Heart; and 10 WHEREAS, after completing his military service, Mr. Rangel graduated from New 11 York University in 1957 and St. John's University Law School in 1960; he worked as a 12 private attorney, assistant U.S. attorney, and legal counsel before entering the world of 13 politics; and 14 WHEREAS, Mr. Rangel served as a United States congressman from New York City 15 for forty-six years and was the first African American to serve as chair of the House Ways 16 and Means Committee; during his nearly five-decade tenure in congress, he earned a 17 reputation for his frankness and sense of humor, his ability to work with others, and his 18 support of progressive policies; and 19 WHEREAS, Mr. Rangel was a founding member of the Congressional Black Caucus 20 and forged a legacy of fighting for justice and opportunity in black communities; his 21 legislative accomplishments include championing the national Empowerment Zone program,

1 Affordable Care Act, Low Income Housing Tax Credit, American Recovery and

- 2 Reinvestment Act of 2009, Africa Growth and Opportunity Act, and the "Rangel
- 3 Amendment" that helped ensure the end of Apartheid in South Africa; he was recognized
- 4 by the Jackie Robinson Foundation and presented with a Lifetime Achievement Award in
- 5 2005; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Charles B. "Charlie" Rangel was an incredible public servant whose life
- 7 and career were defined by his genuine commitment to the United States and its citizens; he
- 8 will be deeply missed, but the legacy of his service to the country shall live on in perpetuity
- 9 in the hearts and minds of those who were privileged to have known and loved him.
- THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
- 11 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby express heartfelt condolences on the death of Charles
- 12 B. "Charlie" Rangel; does hereby extend enduring appreciation for his military service and
