2	To amend and reenact R.S. 37:1432(B), relative to the Louisiana Real Estate Commission;
3	to provide for the terms of appointment of commissioners; to provide for an effective
4	date; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 37:1432(B) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
7	§1432. Louisiana Real Estate Commission; qualifications; terms of office
8	* * *
9	B. Each appointment to the commission shall be for a six-year four-year
10	term. No commissioner shall serve more than one six-year term two four-year terms
11	consecutively. If an appointee has served two four-year terms consecutively as a
12	commissioner, he shall not be eligible to serve again as a commissioner until after
13	four years from the last date he served in such capacity.
14	* * *
15	Section 2. Notwithstanding Section 1 of this Act, any commissioner who serves in
16	such capacity on the effective date of this Act shall be eligible to serve only one four-year
17	term and shall not be eligible to serve again until after four years from the last date he serves
18	in such capacity.

1	Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
2	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
3	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
4	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
5	effective on the day following such approval.
