The LFO anticipates that any increase in expenditure related to these permits will be offset by the fee charged for the permit and inspection.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

Proposed law may result in an increase in Local Fund revenues if municipalities or parishes collect fees for permits and inspections for roof construction and reroofing. The LFO anticipates that any increase in revenue will be used to offset the cost of permitting and inspecting.
