SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 185

COMMENDATIONS. Commends and congratulates Liberty Baptist Church located in Union Parish Louisiana on its 175<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration.

1	A RESOLUTION
2	To commend and congratulate Liberty Baptist Church in Union Parish upon the momentous
3	occasion of its one hundred seventy-fifth anniversary and to recognize its enduring
4	legacy of faith, service, and community commitment.
5	WHEREAS, it is fitting to recognize and honor institutions that have stood as pillars
6	of spiritual guidance, community strength, and historical significance in the state of
7	Louisiana; and
8	WHEREAS, Liberty Baptist Church, one of the oldest churches in Union Parish,
9	celebrates one hundred seventy-five years of continuous ministry, rooted in a legacy of faith,
10	sacrifice, and perseverance; and
11	WHEREAS, the church's humble beginnings featured a first building with split-log
12	pews, serving the congregation for seventeen years before Mr. Louis Lanair generously
13	deeded two acres of land on January 11, 1850, establishing the site where Liberty Baptist
14	Church proudly stands to this day; and
15	WHEREAS, under the leadership of Reverend A.J. Calloway in 1892, a new
16	sanctuary was planned and built using hand-planed lumber, wood pegs, and square nails,
17	with Mr. Crawford as the head carpenter; this structure served faithfully for sixty-three
18	years; and

1	WHEREAS, the church cemetery, established in 1853, includes markers that date
2	even earlier, providing a sacred resting place for generations of faithful members; and
3	WHEREAS, in the early years, devoted pastors often served with little or no
4	compensation, accepting offerings of produce such as eggs, chickens, pork, syrup, and corn
5	as tokens of appreciation from their congregations; and
6	WHEREAS, under the pastoral guidance of Reverend Grey Nolan beginning
7	December 31, 1941, services were expanded, and a more structured worship schedule was
8	implemented; and
9	WHEREAS, in 1947, under Reverend Herman Hayes, Liberty Baptist became a
10	full-time church, and in 1949, a Training Union was organized to further spiritual education;
11	and
12	WHEREAS, under Reverend Clemens Smith, the church expanded in 1950 with the
13	addition of four Sunday School rooms, followed by the formation of the Women's
14	Missionary Union (WMU), Sunbeams Missionary Auxiliary (Sunbeams), Girls in Action
15	(GA's), and Royal Ambassadors (RA's) in 1953, promoting involvement among women and
16	youth; and
17	WHEREAS, in 1955, a new chapter began with the dismantling of the old sanctuary
18	and the building of a new one, made possible in part by the generous donation of timber
19	from widow Eula Pearl Beckley, with the church dedicated under Reverend Lamar Hayes
20	on April 1, 1956; and
21	WHEREAS, the baptistry, lovingly painted by Docia Mae Smith in 1956, remains
22	a cherished symbol of the church's dedication to baptizing new believers in Christ; and
23	WHEREAS, the completion of the Family Life Center in 1998, dedicated in memory
24	of Reverend Bruce Lunsford and his wife Betty, further expanded the church's ministry
25	capabilities; and
26	WHEREAS, Liberty Baptist Church has consistently supported numerous mission
27	efforts including those of Lottie Moon, Annie Armstrong, Georgia Barnett, The Gideons,
28	Samaritan's Purse, Life Choices, Rolling Hills Disaster Relief, and various state and foreign
29	missionaries through the Cooperative Programs; and
30	WHEREAS, the church remains a beacon of prayer, dedicating Wednesday nights

to intercession for community, nation, and global concerns; and
