SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL

- 1. Make effectiveness of <u>proposed law</u> subject to appropriation of monies by the legislature for the implementation of proposed law.
- Adds provisions that blueprints and school mapping data of public school buildings and facilities are not subject to Public Records Law.
- 3. Make technical and conforming changes.

DIGEST OF THE SENATE BILL AS RETURNED TO THE SENATE

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education (BESE) and the Department of Education to coordinate with the Louisiana Center for Safe Schools to provide mapping data of public schools to local law enforcement.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires all school mapping data be collected, produced, and stored within the United States of America.

Proposed law provides guidelines for school mapping data.

<u>Proposed law</u> prohibits modification or update of school mapping data without corresponding updates within the software platforms used by local, parish, state, and federal public safety agencies.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the public school systems will be subject to the requirements of proposed law based off a schedule over a five year period.

Proposed law (R.S. 17:3996(89)) makes proposed law applicable to charter schools.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the law will be known as the "Protect Our Children and Response Act".

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that blueprints and school mapping data of public school buildings and facilities are not subject to the Public Records Law.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
