6	WHEREAS, the Louisiana Commission on Law Enforcement and the Administration
7	of Criminal Justice (LCLE) is charged with developing and implementing a monitoring and
8	evaluation program for the Truancy Assessment Service Centers throughout the state; and
9	WHEREAS, the Louisiana Department of Education established the Success
10	Through Attendance Recovery (STAR) Task Force in 2022; and
11	WHEREAS, Louisiana Supreme Court's judicial administrator's office manages the
12	funds provided by the legislature to assist Families in the Need of Services Assistance
13	Program (FINSAP); and
14	WHEREAS, according to the Louisiana Department of Education, forty-five percent
15	of Louisiana children were truant during the 2021-2022 school year, a dramatic increase
16	from the 2018-2019 school year, prior to the onset of COVID, with only thirty-six percent
17	of children being truant; and
18	WHEREAS, it is imperative that the legislature be informed regarding truancy
