2	To enact R.S. 18:5, relative to prohibiting certain changes to election procedures without
3	legislative approval; to prohibit election officials and the state and parish boards of
4	election supervisors from entering into certain agreements regarding election
5	procedures; to provide for legislative approval of such actions by concurrent
6	resolution; and to provide for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 18:5 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
9	§5. Change in election procedures prohibited; legislative approval
10	A. No state, parish, or local election official or elected official in the
11	executive branch shall enter into any consent decree or settlement agreement
12	regarding the alteration of any election procedure or policy without specific approval
13	of the consent decree or settlement agreement by concurrent resolution adopted by
14	the legislature, in addition to any other approval or authorization required by law.
15	B. Approval by the legislature of a consent decree or settlement agreement
16	by concurrent resolution as provided in this Section shall be conducted in the same
17	manner and by the same procedure established for a suspension of a law pursuant to
18	Article III, Section 20 of the Constitution of Louisiana, except that the fixed period
19	of suspension shall not apply.

1	C. No elected official that is listed in this Section shall enter into a consent
2	decree or settlement agreement related to a redistricting or reapportionment map of
3	the legislature or that modifies any other district map or boundary.
