9	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
10	Section 1. R.S. 47:338.221(E) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
11	§338.221. City of New Orleans; short-term rental occupancy tax
12	* * *
13	E. If a party rents a short-term rental that is located in the city of New
14	Orleans through an online platform, the online platform shall provide the party with
15	a line by line itemization of all assessments, fees, and taxes owed by such party. The
16	online platform shall provide such information on its website and on the final bill
17	issued to the party who rented the short-term rental.
18	Section 2. The provisions of this Act shall become effective on January 1, 2026.
