A RESOLUTION

To designate Wednesday, June 11, 2025, as Master P Day at the state capitol and commends

Percy "Master P" Miller for his many accomplishments and philanthropy.

WHEREAS, Percy "Master P" Miller is a Louisiana legend who has succeeded as a businessman, entrepreneur, music mogul, entertainer, producer, author, speaker, philanthropist, and mental health advocate; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Miller is the founder and CEO of P. Miller Enterprises and No Limit Records; his independent label has grown into an internationally-renowned record company, selling over 100 million records, turning his "make 'em say Ugh!" phrase into one of the most recognized lyrics in the world; he performed during the kick-off ceremony of Super Bowl LIX and serves as an ambassador for entertainment in New Orleans and the world; and

WHEREAS, after establishing himself in the music industry, Mr. Miller enjoyed playing in the NBA for the Charlotte Hornets and the Toronto Raptors; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Miller is the driving force behind Miller Family Foods, a familyowned business committed to strengthening families and communities by promoting active and healthy lifestyles; he has a business portfolio that includes apparel, shoes, restaurant franchises, beverages, film and television production, and more; and

WHEREAS, although Mr. Miller enjoys a significant measure of personal success, he is most passionate about his philanthropic endeavors; his primary goal is to educate and empower members of the next generation to take control of their careers and financial futures, and he teaches financial literacy to students; and

WHEREAS, as the founder and chairman of the Louisiana-based Team Hope Foundation, Mr. Miller is committed to improving the lives of youth and the elderly through programs designed to enhance their quality of life; he is a mental health advocate and serves as an ambassador for the National Alliance on Mental Illness; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Miller was presented with an honorary doctorate from Lincoln University, and he has been presented with a Key to the City from Memphis, Tennessee; Los Angeles, California; Louisville, Kentucky; Charlotte, North Carolina; Jackson, Mississippi; Houston, Texas; Gulfport, Mississippi; Baton Rouge, Louisiana; and New Orleans, Louisiana; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Miller was recently announced as the president of basketball operations for the University of New Orleans Privateers basketball program, and he is deserving of the highest recognition for his continued commitment to serving the New Orleans community.
