7	and local elected officials and university administrators be adequately compensated; and
8	WHEREAS, it would benefit the Senate to study the compensation of state and local
9	elected officials and university administrators in Louisiana and in other states; and
10	WHEREAS, the legislature, by law, establishes compensation for various elected
11	offices; and
12	WHEREAS, the legislature will benefit from the recommendations from the Senate
13	Committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs regarding appropriate adjustments to salary
14	structures and total compensation packages for state and local elected officials and university
15	administrators.
16	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana does
17	hereby request the Senate Committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs to study the
