2 To commend Revolt1811 Museum on the institution's contributions to public education,
3 tourism, and chronicling African American history in Louisiana.

4 WHEREAS, the citizens of Louisiana recognize the profound significance of African
5 American history and culture as pivotal components of our national narrative; and

6 WHEREAS, Revolt1811 Museum stands as a vital institution dedicated to the
7 preservation, education, and celebration of African American heritage, which includes the
8 historical 1811 Slave Revolt – a defining moment that echoed the struggles for freedom,
9 equality, and justice that shape our society; and

10 WHEREAS, Revolt1811 Museum serves not only as a repository of historical
11 artifacts but as an educational platform that informs and inspires visitors about the
12 courageous efforts of local civil rights leaders who have fought valiantly against systemic
13 inequalities and injustices; and

14 WHEREAS, in its commitment to fostering community engagement, Revolt1811
15 Museum actively involves citizens in the celebration and education of Juneteenth,
16 commemorating the emancipation of enslaved African Americans and promoting awareness
17 of this historical milestone; on June 22, 2025, Revolt1811 Museum will observe Juneteenth
18 with a day of events at the museum to herald an essential part of the collective journey
19 towards freedom and equality; and

20 WHEREAS, Revolt1811 Museum plays a critical role in boosting tourism in the
21 vibrant community of LaPlace, inviting visitors from across the nation and around the world

1 to engage with Louisiana's rich cultural tapestry and to learn about the herculean efforts of
2 those who have shaped the fight for civil rights; and

3 WHEREAS, the contributions of Revolt1811 Museum extend beyond the walls of
4 the museum itself, sparking important conversations about the past and present struggles for
5 justice, highlighting inequalities based on race, sex, color, and creed that continue to
6 challenge our society; and

7 WHEREAS, the efforts of Revolt1811 Museum align with the vision of the state to
8 create an informed citizenry that fosters tolerance, understanding, and equity among all
9 communities; and

10 WHEREAS, Revolt1811 Museum urges all citizens to acknowledge and participate
11 in the invaluable educational pursuits offered by the museum to honor the legacy of civil
12 rights leaders, engage in the celebration of Juneteenth, and contribute to the continuing
13 dialogue for justice and equality for all.

14 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
