

SENATE BILL NO. 60

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 33:381(C)(37), relative to municipal officers of the village of Hall Summit;
3 to provide for the abolition of the office of police chief and the police department in
4 the village of Hall Summit; to authorize the town to contract with other law
5 enforcement entities in the parish for law enforcement services; to provide with
6 respect to terms of office and vacancies; and to provide for related matters

7 Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published.

8 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

9 Section 1. R.S. 33:381(C)(37) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

10 §381. Municipal officers

14 **(37)(a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the**
15 **board of aldermen of the village of Hall Summit may, upon recommendation of**
16 **the mayor, abolish the office of chief of police of the village or determine that**
17 **the chief shall not be elected at-large but shall be appointed by the board upon**
18 **recommendation of the mayor. No such action by the board shall be effective**
19 **until the end of the term of the police chief in office at the time of the action or**
20 **when a vacancy occurs in the office, whichever occurs first.**

21 **(b) If the office of chief of police is abolished and the municipal police**
22 **department is abolished pursuant to R.S. 33:362(C), the mayor and board of**
23 **aldermen shall be further authorized to contract with or enter into a**

1 cooperative endeavor agreement with any law enforcement entity or officer
2 within Red River Parish for law enforcement services for the village.
