Miller

Existing law provides for the requirements to conduct exit polling.

New law requires that exit polls be conducted in a nondisruptive manner.

New law retains existing law and defines "exit poll" to be a poll of voters by a bona fide news gathering organization leaving a polling place to gather basic demographic information and determine how voters voted on candidates and propositions in an election.

New law provides that the term "exit poll" not be construed to include polls about races, propositions, or issues not on the ballot, or dissemination of information to voters.

Effective August 1, 2025.
