<u>Prior law</u> provided for the jurisdiction of the commissioner of conservation over the geologic sequestration of carbon dioxide.

<u>New law</u> changes commissioner to secretary. Further requires the secretary to give substantial consideration to local government comments when determining the appropriate course of action in any matter that requires a public comment period or hearing.

<u>Existing law</u> provides for issuance of certificates of public convenience and necessity and certificates of completion of injection operations, after public hearing and satisfaction of certain requirements.

<u>New law</u> provides that a certificate of public convenience and necessity issued to a transporter of carbon dioxide prior to the effective date of <u>new law</u>, shall remain valid.

Effective June 20, 2025.
