

## **RÉSUMÉ DIGEST**

**ACT 115 (SB 145)**

**2025 Regular Session**

**McMath**

Existing law establishes classes of permits for construction on certain water bodies and provides for their issuance by the state land office. Construction of a bulkhead or flood protection structure in proximity to the bank or shore requires a Class B Permit.

Existing law requires a coastal use permit for certain uses of lands in the coastal zone, and provides for issuance of such permits by the Dept. of Energy and Natural Resources.

New law prohibits the issuance of Class B Permits from March 17, 2025, to January 1, 2030, for bulkhead construction in St. Tammany Parish within a defined area that includes Lake Emfred and Suter Slip.

New law prohibits the issuance of coastal use permits from March 17, 2025, to January 1, 2030, for bulkhead construction in the same designated area.

Effective June 8, 2025.
