<u>Existing law</u> provides for the crimes of cruelty to persons with infirmities and exploitation of persons with infirmities. <u>Existing law</u> includes persons who are aged.

New law changes the term "aged" to "elderly".

 $\underline{\text{New law}}$ adds financial exploitation to the crime of exploitation of elderly persons or persons with infirmities.

 $\underline{\text{New law}}$ provides penalties for a second conviction of exploitation of elderly persons or persons with infirmities.

<u>New law</u> provides that a person convicted of exploitation of elderly persons or persons with infirmities shall make full restitution to the victim and anyone else who suffered a financial loss.

Effective August 1, 2025.
