ACT 322 (SB 70)

Prior law authorized remote patient monitoring services provided through telehealth to be used by a patient who meets any two of the following qualifications:

- (1) Has been diagnosed with one or more chronic conditions.
- (2) Has a recent history of costly service use due to one or more chronic conditions as evidenced by two or more hospitalizations, including emergency room visits, in the last 12 months.
- (3) Has a recommendation from the patient's healthcare provider for disease management services through remote patient monitoring.

New law authorizes patients to use remote patient monitoring services if the patient has a recommendation from the patient's healthcare provider for disease management services through remote patient monitoring and meets one of the following qualifications:

- (1) Has been diagnosed with one or more chronic conditions.
- (2) Has a recent history of costly service use due to one or more chronic conditions as evidenced by two or more hospitalizations, including emergency room visits, in the last 12 months.
- (3) Is a pregnant or postpartum woman.
- (4) Is an infant who has been discharged from a hospital after requiring neonatal intensive care.

Effective June 11, 2025.
